### Inside IDEON's Commitment to Fire and Moisture Resistance

Nothing can ruin those amazing fabrics and fillings you picked out faster than fire and water. So we at IDEON do everything we can to keep our seats safe and dry, adhering to the most stringent industry fire-safety specifications and offering additional moisture protection for those who'd like it. With IDEON, you can be sure all your hard work and vision will be appreciated as much as the deliciously beautiful furniture you've selected.

#### Fire Resistance

The California Bureau of Home Furnishings and Thermal Insulation (BHFTI) require manufacturers to make all California-sold upholstered furniture flame-retardant. Since 1975, the Bureau has developed several performance-based flammability standards, called technical bulletins to set the bar for fire safety. IDEON applies innovative solutions and products to achieve these flame-resistance standards, while doing everything possible to not compromise the environment in the process.

#### **California Technical Bulletin 117 (TB-117)**

All fabrics, vinyl and/or leathers, and resilient filling material (i.e., foam and Dacron) offered by IDEON meet TB-117 at minimum.

- Consult the individual IDEON fabric cards to review fabric specifications inherent in each fabric offered.
- IDEON assumes no responsibility for the flame retardancy of any COM.
- Because we offer such a vast array of fabrics with varying degrees of flame retardancy, we suggest you consult the published technical data of the fabric supplier when selecting your fabric choice.

#### **California Technical Bulletin 133**

Most standard IDEON fabrics, leathers and many COM fabric and leathers, when used in combination with proper components, can meet the requirements of the composite test for California Technical Bulletin 133 and the Boston Fire Code (an open flame test developed for public occupancy furniture sold in Boston that uses methodology different from TB-133 tests and criteria).

- Please refer to the back cover of the IDEON fabric card or fabric specification for TB-133 designation.
- Due to fiber contents, some fabrics may require additional treatment prior to being sent to IDEON for application.
- COM fabrics will be evaluated on an individual basis and may require the testing of the upholstery on the frames.
- If testing is required, additional cost and lead time will apply. Call Customer Support for more details.
- To receive TB-133 or Boston Fire Code certification, please contact Customer Support for lead time and additional costs.

Moisture Barrier Program

IDEON understands the importance of this protection to improve seating fabric durability and maintenance requirements for upholstery textiles used in healthcare, education, corporate, and college and university applications. IDEON's got it covered with an optional moisture barrier to seats and backs on all our seating products.

To select, please specify the moisture barrier option code (MBS for seats, MBB for Back) in the option section of the model number and add \$50 per each seat and/or back. For example, when ordering a settee with moisture barriers specified for **both** the seat **and** back the list price would be \$200 (4 x \$50).
